17 **from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the**  
18 **allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for**  
19 **distribution to counties for economic development activities estab-**  
20 **lished by section 24, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium**  
21 **beginning July 1, 2007, is reduced by \$6,399,691.**

22 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys**  
23 **from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the**  
24 **allocation to the Sports Lottery Account established by section 23,**  
25 **chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,**  
26 **is increased by \$10,017.**

27 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys**  
28 **from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the**  
29 **allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund established by**

14 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department  
15 established by section 3 (10), chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the  
16 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$2,788,960.

17 **“SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
18 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
19 allocation to the Department of Transportation established by section  
20 9, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1,  
21 2007, is decreased by \$422,057.

22 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
23 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
24 allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services es-  
25 tablished by section 18, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the  
26 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$167,538.

27 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
28 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
29 allocation to the Department of Higher Education established by sec-  
30 tion 27, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning

1 July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$1,218,858.

2 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
3 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
4 allocation to the Housing and Community Services Department estab-  
5 lished by section 15, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium  
6 beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$3,576.

7 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
8 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
9 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department

12 **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys

16 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$62,589.

17 **“SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys

23 **“SECTION 15.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys

27 is decreased by \$112,000.

28 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys

30 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department

1 for department operations established by section 3 (1), chapter 745,  
2 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased  
3 by \$465,000.

4 **SECTION 17.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
5 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
6 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department  
7 for the Oregon Community Development Fund established by section  
8 3 (3), chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July  
9 1, 2007, is decreased by \$2,883,808.

10 **SECTION 18.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
11 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
12 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department  
13 for the Strategic Reserve for Workforce established by section 3 (4),  
14 chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,  
15 is decreased by \$341,244.

16 **SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
17 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
18 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department  
19 for targeted service providers established by section 3 (5), chapter 745,  
20 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased  
21 by \$100,000.

22 **SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
23 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, the  
24 allocation to the Economic and Community Development Department  
25 for the Oregon Film and Video Office established by section 3 (9),  
26 chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,  
27 is decreased by \$64,085.

28 **SECTION 21.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys  
29 from the Watershed Improvement Operating Fund, the allocation from  
30 the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board to the Department of En-

1 vironmental Quality for activities and projects to implement section 4  
2 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, established by section 4,  
3 chapter 732, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,  
4 is increased by \$427,630.

5 **SECTION 22.** There is appropriated to the School Day Restoration  
6 Fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General  
7 Fund, the amount of \$51,000,000 for the purpose of carrying out the  
8 provisions of sections 19 to 21, chapter \_\_\_\_\_ Oregon Laws 2009 (En-  
9 rolled Senate Bill 581).

10 **SECTION 23.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
11 the amount of \$16,750 is established for the biennium beginning July  
12 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal  
13 funds collected or received by the office of the Governor.

14 **SECTION 24.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
15 the amount of \$55,639,902 is established for the biennium beginning  
16 July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fed-  
17 eral funds collected or received by the Department of Higher Educa-  
18 tion.

19 **SECTION 25.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
20 the amount of \$115,360,098 is established for the biennium beginning  
21 July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fed-  
22 eral funds collected or received by the Department of Education for  
23 the State School Fund.

24 **SECTION 26.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
25 General Fund appropriation made to the Water Resources Department  
26 by section 47 (2), chapter 16, Oregon Laws 2008, for the biennium be-  
27 ginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$694,165.

28 **SECTION 27.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
29 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Veterans' Af-  
30 fairs by section 48 (1), chapter 16, Oregon Laws 2008, for the biennium

1 beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$185,941.

2 **“SECTION 28.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
3 the limitation on expenditures established by Section 1, Chapter 19,  
4 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the  
5 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other  
6 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from  
7 federal services agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal  
8 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon  
9 State Board of Nursing, is increased by \$110,000.

10 **“SECTION 29.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
11 the limitation on expenditures established by Section 1, Chapter 37,  
12 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the  
13 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other  
14 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from  
15 federal services agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal  
16 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon  
17 Board of Dentistry, is increased by \$50,000.

18 **“SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
19 the limitation on expenditures established by Section 1, Chapter 38,  
20 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the  
21 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other  
22 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from  
23 federal services agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal  
24 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the State  
25 Board of Psychologist Examiners, is increased by \$98,000.

26 **“SECTION 31.** Section 37, chapter 16, Oregon Laws 2008, is repealed.

27 **“SECTION 32.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate  
28 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
29 declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
